The 31st of October

It's already October. Can you believe it? Where did September go? In my perspective it *flew* by! Now it's October and with its arrival, we can relish the autumn colors of the maple trees, pumpkin spice lattes, apple cider, and the Hilton Apple Fest. Of course, at the end of October there's Halloween. On a recent bike ride traveling past Long Pond and Cranberry Pond, I began to see Halloween decorations popping up on various yards. One of them in particular caught my eye. It was a skeleton reclining on a lawn chair. Somewhat scary, but also quite funny at the same time. Also showing up here and there around town are haunted houses. We passed by one at the corner of Latta Road and Dewey Avenue. I asked my wife, Rose, if she wanted to go check it out. She replied, "No way!" Neither one of us really enjoys getting frightened. Do you?

For the church, October 31 is much more than just getting spooked by a ghost or goblin. It's actually a crucial date for the protestant churches in particular. On the 31st of October in 1517, Martin Luther posted his 95 Theses on the door of the Castle Church in Wittenberg, Germany. That date is considered to be the start of the Protestant Reformation. Luther had no intention of starting a new church or forming separate denominations. After carefully studying the book of Romans, Luther discovered that a person is justified by faith apart from observation of the law. Having this spiritual insight empowered Luther to urge the church to reform by correcting abuses of authority and misinterpretation of Scripture. His goal was to bring about change in the Roman Catholic Church of the sixteenth century. However, the Roman Catholic Church of his day was a well-established entity that refused to change. In time, Luther parted ways with the mother church. Eventually, new congregations and denominations were formed that we call Protestant since they originated out of Luther's (and other reformers) protest of the way things were. Today we see protestant churches all around our neighborhoods of various affiliations and denominations, such as Lutheran, Methodist, Presbyterian, Baptist, and Reformed. As you know these churches not

only have much in common but also contain significant differences.

In the month of October, we'll focus on Reformation themes at Lakeview Community Church. The sermon series will feature the five solas of the Reformation. Historically the church has leaned heavily on the Latin language. Sola is a Latin word meaning only or alone. I'll start the series with a sermon based on Sola Scriptura—by Scripture Alone. Rose will do the second sermon featuring Sola Gratia - by Grace Alone. I'll be back on the third Sunday with Sola Fide - by Faith Alone. On the final Sunday of October, Lynn Allhusen will go behind the pulpit to focus on Solus Christus - through Christ alone (our daughter Annaliese is running the Marine Corps Marathon in our nation's capitol that weekend). The series actually overlaps into November. When we return from DC, I'll preach the final sermon of the series on November 3. The conclusion places the spotlight on Soli Deo Gloria - Glory to God alone.

Overall, I pray that October is a great month for you; whether you are listening to a sermon, carving a pumpkin, eating a honey-crisp apple, or raking leaves. May God bless you and keep you this fall and during every season of your life.

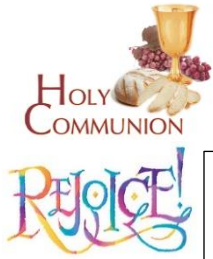

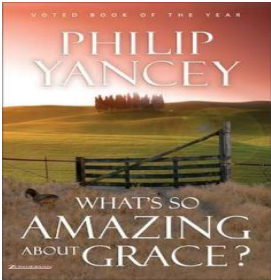

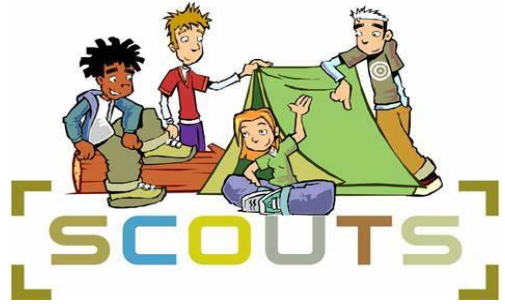
