SERVING THE CHURCH

Many and various are the ways to serve the church. Some of you enjoy singing in the choir or rejoicing with the Praise Team. Others make the church property beautiful by mowing the grass or chopping down diseased ash trees. And let's not forget those who provide us with sweet snacks to promote fellowship after the worship service is over. These are just a few ways to serve the church. In the months of May and June, I'll be serving the church by attending meetings. There will be multiple meetings representing all four levels of church government in the Reformed Church in America (RCA): General Synod, Regional Synod, Classis, and local congregations.

Let's start with the one in which we have the most familiarity: Our local congregation. Lakeview Community Church has consistory meetings monthly, typically on the third Monday night of the month. So, on May 19, I'll be leading the meeting as the president of our Lakeview Consistory. However, I'm not the only one. We have three deacons and three elders, including Joe Romanczyk who is the vice president. And don't forget about Betsy Leipold who faithfully takes meeting notes as our clerk.

The following day (May 20), I'll drive to Interlaken for the meeting of the Rochester Classis. I'm sure it'll be a nice drive since Interlaken is nestled between two of the finger lakes. I look forward to this biannual meeting of reformed churches in Western New York, but I won't be the only one. Chris Dorland will represent Lakeview as an elder delegate. Under the faithful leadership of Anita Manuele, I'm confident it will be a good meeting with a full agenda. One item we'll be paying close

attention to is the subject of grant proposals. The Classis plans to distribute over \$200,000 to seven churches who have made grant proposals. Pray that Lakeview's proposal to fund a new commissioned pastor program for three years will receive a positive review!

On the first Sunday of May, I'll be traveling to Castleton-on-Hudson with Rose Admiraal. I have been assigned to be a minister delegate and Rose will be a guest at the Regional Synod of Albany. Castleton-on-Hudson is a small village south of Albany. It's the location of Emmanuel Reformed Church, a congregation that has been around since 1852! I'm hoping that this historic church has comfortable pews! The meetings taking place at the church will be held on Sunday evening and Monday too. I'm sure we'll have many important matters to discuss, including the restructuring that is taking place. How will we adapt to change at the regional level? Please pray for all the delegates and the churches they represent.

In early June, I'll be flying to Tucson, Arizona, for RCA General Synod. I'm sure that it'll be blazing hot in the desert of the southwest. However, I'm hoping that the meeting hall has air conditioning! I have been assigned by the classis to be a minister delegate but I won't be the only one attending from Classis Rochester. Rev. Sarah Palsma will have a very important role—vice president of synod. Rev. Chris Fluit will also be a minister delegate. Remember him? Chris has preached at Lakeview Community Church. Currently, Chris is the head Chaplain of Highland Hospital.

I'll be away at General Synod from June 5 to June 10. This lengthy series of meetings encompasses a Sunday, so Rose has offered to preach in my place. On Sunday, June 8, Rose will preach on Pentecost Sunday. We celebrate the powerful arrival of the Holy Spirit!

Overall, I'll be attending quite a few meetings in May and June. Now I like meetings as much as the next guy, but that's a lot! Does anyone want to trade places? Please pray for me that I'll have good endurance and patience with the process. May I have a humble heart, ready and willing to serve the church of Christ.

Neighborhood Shoreline Spring Clean-Up
